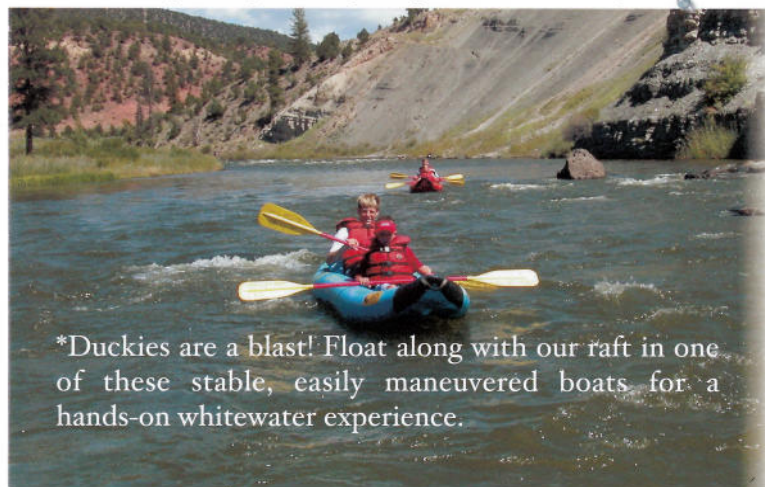

Where We Raft The Colorado River:

We cruise Class I-III rapids on the Colorado from May through October. Trips meet at State Bridge Landing (directions on reverse).

Magnificent scenery and family friendly rapids await on one of the country's most famous rivers.



The Eagle River:

We run the Class III-IV rapids on the Eagle River from May through July. Trips meet at the town of Eagle (directions on reverse).



Our guides love this challenging whitewater trip. Rushing rapids, fed by melting Rocky Mountain snow, make for an intense trip designed to make adrenalin pound!

Colorado River Trips (Trips originate at State Bridge Landing):

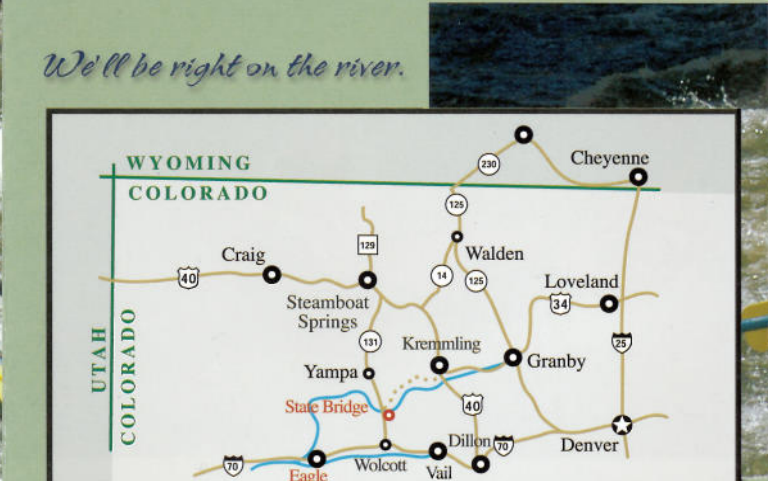
- From Steamboat: Highway 40 east to Highway 131; turn right and follow Highway 131 for 55 miles.
- From Summit County and Vail: I-70 west to Wolcott (exit 157); follow Highway 131 14 miles. (35 miles from Vail; 65 miles from Summit County.)
- From Winter Park: Highway 40 west to Kremmling, left on Highway 9. Go two miles; right on Trough Road; follow for 28 miles (68 miles from Winter Park).

Eagle River Trips I-70 to Eagle; follow signs to rest area.
