Driving Directions

To our Kremmling office
(All Upper Colorado Rafting Trips)

Denver: I-70 west to US Hwy 40 (Winter Park exit). Stay on Hwy 40 into Kremmling. Our office is one of the first buildings on the left, just past the Kremmling Airport. Approximate drive time: 2hrs.

Winter Park & Grand Lake: US Hwy 40 west to Kremmling. Mad Adventures is on the left side of the highway, just past the Kremmling Airport. Approximate drive time: 1hr.

Summit County & Vail: Take Hwy 9 north to Kremmling. Turn right (east) onto US Hwy 40. The Mad office is on the right side at the far end of town, just past West Grand High School. Approximate drive time: 45 mins to 1hr.

Steamboat Springs: Take US Hwy 40 east to Kremmling. Mad Adventures is on the right side at the far end of town, just past West Grand High School. Approximate drive time: 1hr.

To our Downieville office
(Clear Creek Rafting Trips)

Mad Adventures is located on the north side of I-70 in Downieville and shares a building with Starbucks.

Denver: I-70 west to Downieville exit 234. Approximate drive time: 30 - 45 mins.

Winter Park & Grand Lake: US Hwy 40 over Berthoud Pass. Take I-70 east toward Denver. 2 miles to Downieville exit 234. Approximate drive time: 45 mins.

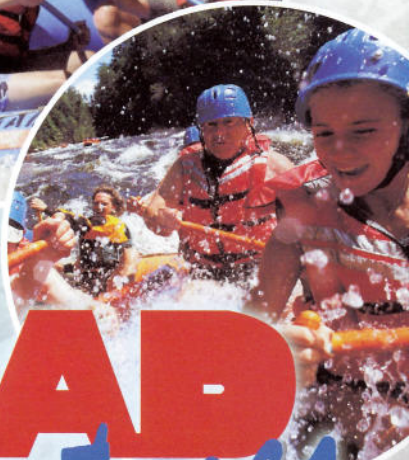
Summit County & Vail: Take I-70 east toward Denver to Downieville exit 234. Approximate drive time: 45 mins.

Steamboat Springs: Take US Hwy 40 east through Winter Park and over Berthoud Pass. Take I-70 east toward Denver to Downieville exit 234. Approximate drive time: 2hrs 15 mins.

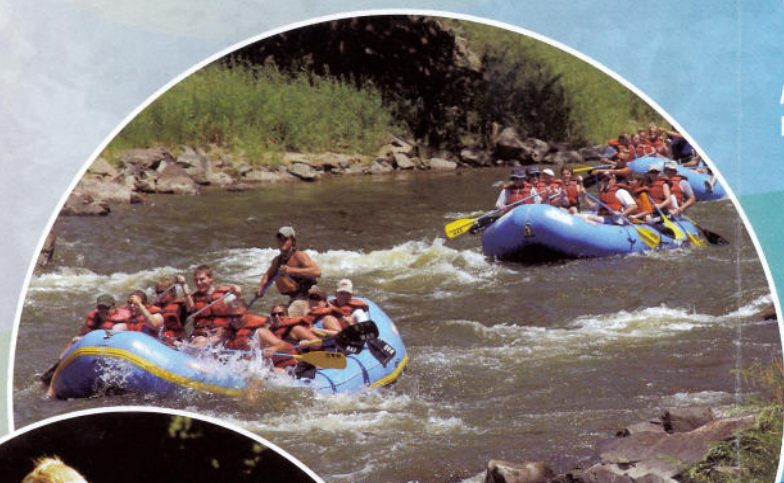
